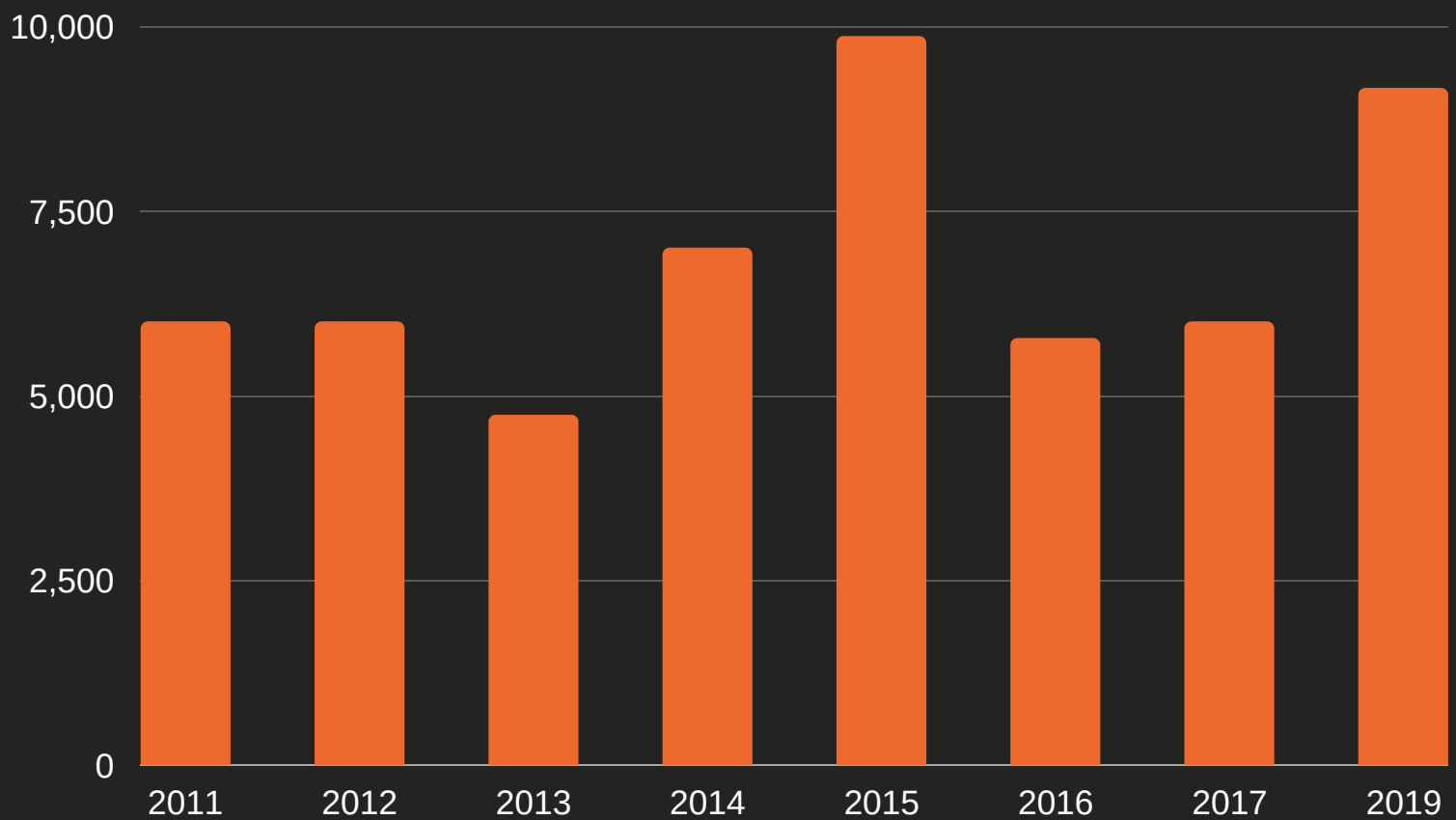


# About Health Camps

In slums and rural areas people do not have access to adequate health services. The poor often neglect their health and well-being because of the burden of medical expenses. Weekly and yearly health camps are organised by Sahayata Trust to provide medical aid to the needy. In such camps, doctors from the United States and the United Kingdom collaborate with doctors in India to address medical concerns of people living in rural India. Medical checkups, lab tests and medicines are provided free of cost. Specialists include emergency physicians, pediatricians, geriatricians, surgeons, ophthalmologists, family physicians and others. Patients travel long distances seeking free medical advice and treatment.
