HYDERABAD FLOODS OCTOBER-2020

Hyderabad recorded 199 mm rain on October 13th, 2020, the highest ever recorded October rain in over 100 years. The authorities declared high alert in the city. It was a dreadful day for the residents of Hyderabad. Water gushed into homes, roads caved in, trees fell and blocked the road, many houses collapsed, valuable possessions washed away in the water. About 20 people and a two-month-old died, many injured. Due to the rising levels of water, 13 of the 17 gates of Himayatsagar reservoir were opened, resulting in 30 cars and trucks to wash away. The one day rain caused an overwhelming loss to the entire city.

SAHAYATA TRUST ON THE FIELD

The most affected part of the city is the old city, where the roads caved in, waterlogged on roads. Traveling by road in these parts of the city in the present situation is out of the question as water gushed away most of the vehicles. The Sahayata Trust team used the ship to help the victims.
