







## HYDERABAD FLOODS RELIEF WORK



## Work Done till 19th October, 2020

The heavy rains in Hyderabad caused heavy loss to the people especially in the old city, where the roads caved in, waterlogged on roads. Traveling by road in these parts of the city in the present situation is out of the question as water gushed away most of the vehicles. The first day Sahayata Trust team used the boats to reach out to the victims and provided 2000 naan roti, 500 rice packets and milk to the victims.

During the remaining days, Sahayata Trust team reached the most affected areas of the city and provided cooked meals, milk, blankets and clothing to the flood victims. The victims were provided the following items:

- 3500 Cooked meals
- 5004 liters Milk in different localities
- Setup of Relief camp at VIP's International School, Shaheen Nagar
- 80 Blankets
- 750 beneficiaries (Kids, Ladies & Gents) -Clothing
