



A Glimpse of the situation

- Worst Affected Areas: Omer colony in Hafeez Babanagar, Gulshan Iqbal colony, Lalithabagh, Al Jubail Colony, Osman Nagar.
- These Colonies inundated with water as high as 12-14 Feet.
- Overflowing sewage channels. Streets full of slush and Mud making it hard for people to even enter homes.
- As the people started getting back home, the streets were full of mattresses, furniture etc. deemed unusable by the people.
- Loss of Household items, Furniture, Vehicles, Business stock, Documents and in some cases the entire home altogether.




