

Our commitment to education is evident through a range of projects, including schools, colleges, and skill development centres; we also provide free hostel facilities.

Additionally, we provide scholarships to those in need and extend interest-free loans to deserving students, ensuring they have access to exceptional educational opportunities.

This year, over 16,300+ individuals have benefited from our diverse educational programs.





- Over 650 beneficiaries enrolled in our skill centers, mastering technical courses like paramedical and mobile repair training. They're now skilled professionals ready for promising careers.
- We've helped 2,102 orphans across India with our Orphan Support Program, providing essentials like food, clothing, shelter, and educational assistance.
- Initiated the Jahangirabad Incubation Center to foster the entrepreneurial spirit among the students as a fellow partner unit
- Commenced the Women's Data Science Scholarship in collaboration with Full Stack Academy to accelerate technical learning among women. We have also arranged a free bus shuttle service for them for easy and safe commute.
- Rural Education and Economic Development Project: We presently have 112 one-room schools that seek to help students in the most rural parts of India avail quality education and contribute to the upliftment of the communities they are a part of.


